

Green Tables Philadelphia Spring Farm Tour / April 24, 2016 Cheese! Baby Goats!!! Brunch!!!

Les Dames d'Escoffier Philadelphia organized a spring tour of three Chester County farms: <u>Wyebrook Farm</u>, <u>Conebella Farm</u> and <u>Amazing Acres</u>. The tour was open to Les Dames chapter members and their guests.

The day started at <u>Wyebrook Farm</u> with a brunch featuring products from Wyebrook and other Chester County producers and continued with a tractor tour of the farm's 355 acres. The farm's manager led the tour and explained the history of the land and its uses, as well as the goals and vision of its owner, Dean Carlson.

The next stop on the tour was three miles away at <u>Conebella Farm</u>, home of Pam and Don Gable, who welcomed the group to their third-generation dairy farm. The visit included an introduction to their individually-named cows, a tour of the farm and cheese tasting. Guests were also able to buy some of their excellent cheddar and other cows' milk cheeses.

The farm tour concluded ten miles down the road at <u>Amazing Acres Goat Dairy</u>. Owners Lynne and Will Reid gave a tour of the Amazing Acres cheese factory and goat farm. In addition to a cheese tasting, guests also enjoyed the opportunity to hold the many adorable baby goats!
