

CULINARY AWARD: Welbeck Abbey School of Artisan Food (North Nottinghamshire, England) & London Food Tour

HOSTS: Dame Alison Swan Parente (Welbeck Abbey) and Dame Jacqui Pickles (London)

TIME FRAME: July 22-26, 2019 at Welbeck Abbey, plus two days in London either before or after (TBD)

The London Chapter of LDEI is pleased to offer this exceptional award which includes five days at Welbeck Abbey, a grand estate of 15,000 acres in Sherwood Forest, North Nottinghamshire, England. The itinerary at the School, which focuses on all aspects of artisan food production, will include various field trips and three days on how to perfect a baguette. The winner will reside at Welbeck Abbey, home of Dame Alison Swan Parente, founder of the School of Artisan Food. In London, the winner will spend two days at the home of Dame Jacqui Pickles, President of LDEI London. Excursions will incorporate various aspects of the flourishing London food scene, including visits to London's Saturday markets. Transportation between London and Welbeck Abbey will be provided. *This experience is particularly well-suited for an applicant involved in the production of artisanal food products, farm-to-table cuisine, and/or food policy.*
